At the outset, the Chairman TBSP welcomed the Members to the Executive Committee meeting of the Parishad and explained that this meeting is called for to discuss various steps to be taken after the issue of approving certain schemes of the Parishad.

1. CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST EXECUTIVE COMMITTE MEETING:

The Minutes of the last Executive Committee meeting held on 17.06.2020 have been read over and confirmed.

2. Construction of Viprahita Brahmin Sadan:

The Executive Committee have been informed of the latest stage of construction of Brahmin Sadan at Gopanpally (V) of Rangareddy District.

3. Vivekananda Overseas Education Scheme:

The Executive Committee have been informed that for all the (57) candidates who have been issued sanction letters after the approval of Executive Committee; amount is being reimbursed on par with previous cases. Apart from that the Executive Committee have ratified the issuance of sanction letters to the following two (2) students whose cases were deferred earlier for want of proper documents which have been submitted recently.

Further Executive Committee have approved the proposal regarding issuance of sanction letter to one Mr. Sannidhanam Anurag S/o. Sri Sannidhanam Narendar Kumar who got admission in Business Management Course in FANSHAWE College, Canada whose case was deferred for want of confirmation letter from University with regard to duration of the course, which has been submitted recently by the said individual.

4. Brahmin Entrepreneurial Development Scheme of Telangana:

Executive Committee have been informed that considering the huge pendency of applications received under this scheme and the pandemic situation prevailing in the State, the interviews are being conducted by the selection committee through online (Whatsapp video call) and so far, as many as (811) applicants have been interviewed in this mode. Out of the eligible (639) cases as many as (371) cases that have been got verified physically, have been placed before the Executive Committee for approval. The Committee have approved the same. Further one more case relating to one Sri Puranam Sunil, S/o. Sri P. Shyam Sundar Rao, which has been kept pending for want of non submission of proper quotation has also been approved on submission of the correct document. Thus the Executive Committee have approved a total of (372) cases for disbursement of subsidy to a tune of Rs.9,66,43,560/- by depositing the respective subsidy amounts into the individual bank accounts of beneficiaries. Committee have been minored and rentarial

Apart from that the Executive Committee have ratified the decision of disbursing subsidy to a tune of Rs.3,90,000/- to one Sri Tiruvarangam Srinivas who had changed his trade from Play school to Paper plate manufacturing unit.

The Executive Committee have approved the proposal for reimbursing the fee to as many as (18) students who have fulfilled the requirements as per existing guidelines.

6. Veda/Shastra Pandits Honororium:

The Executive Committee have ratified the decision with regard to sanctioning of honororium to a tune of Rs.2,500/-per month in favor of Sri Maddikunta Srinivasa Chary (91 years), scholar in Krishna Yajurvedam, basing on the recommendations of Vedic Committee headed by Sri Ashtakala Ram Mohan Rao.

7. Engagement of services of Retired officers of Industries Department for physical verification of selected beneficiaries under BEST scheme:

The Executive Committee have also been informed that in view of the COVID situation the physical verification of beneficiaries selected under BEST scheme is being conducted by engaging the services of two Retired Officers of Assistant/
Deputy Director cadre in Industries Department. They have been designated as program consultants for a monthly emoluments of Rs.40,000/- each and were requested to complete physical verification in not less than (200) cases by each per month.

Further the Committee have been informed that a proposal in this regard has been sent to Government for ratification and that the orders from Government are awaited.

8. Inviting new applications under various schemes for the year 2020-21

Taking the requests of members of Brahmin Community for giving an opportunity to submit new applications under various schemes into consideration, the Executive Committee have

fulfilled the requirements as per existing suidelines.

resolved to keep the option of submitting applications through online open from 02-11-2020 to 30-11-2020 and directed the Administrator, TBSP to take necessary action in this regard.
