
I invite your attention to the reference 1st cited, G. Dhana Laxmi R/o Nizamabad has represented that she belongs to OC - Kamma Caste with an annual income of Rs. 1.30 lakhs as per meeseva income certificate. Further, she also informed that her son G.Sithan Chowdary got a seat in Siddhartha College, Ghaksekar Medchal District during counseling but the officials, have not accepted her Income certificate duly informing that Income must be below Rs.1.00 Lakh for EBC category under Post Matric Scholarships scheme.

In this regard, it is to inform that Government in reference cited, has informed that other communities (OC's) who are Economically Backward having Income less than Rs. 2.00 Lakh per annum in Urban areas and Rs.1.50 Lakh per annum in Rural areas are hereby defined as Economically Backward Classes (EBCs), which is applicable to all schemes/ programmes /other benefits provided to the EBCs under Backward Welfare programmes.

In this connection, it is to informed that as per the above Government orders the student is eligible under EBC category for Post Matric Scholarship scheme. Further, it is also informed that certain students have also orally informed that the Conveners are informing them that the said Government orders are only for Kalyana Lakshmi Pathkam.

In view of the above, it is clarified that the G.O. issued in the reference 2nd is applicable to all schemes/ programmes /other benefits implemented by BC Welfare Department including Scholarships. Hence please avoid hardship to the students & accept their income certificates for Rs. 2.00 lakhs in Urban areas & Rs. 1.50 lakhs in Rural areas.
