

MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING OF TELANGANA BRAHMIN SAMKSHEMA PARISHAD HELD ON 06.01.2023 AT 11.30AM IN THE OFFICE OF THE CHAIRMAN, TELANGANA BRAHMIN SAMKSHEMA PARISHAD, DHARMIK BHAVAN, BOGGULAKUNTA, ABIDS, HYDERABAD.

At the outset, the Chairman TBSP welcomed the Members to the Executive Committee meeting of the Parishad and explained that this meeting is called for to discuss certain agenda items and the following deliberations held.

1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the Last Executive Committee Meeting:

The Minutes of the last Executive Committee meeting held on 10.06.2022 have been read over and confirmed.

2. Construction of Viprahita Brahmin Sadan:

The Executive Committee members have been apprised of the progress of construction of Brahmin Sadan. They have been informed that the construction activity at Brahmin Sadan complex in Gopanpally almost came to an end and waiting to be inaugurated. In this regard, the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) has been requested to communicate suitable date for fixing the inauguration programme as per the convenience of Hon'ble Chief Minister, however, the same is awaited from CMO.

3. Brahmin Entrepreneurship Scheme of Telangana (BEST):

The Executive Committee members have been informed that due to insufficiency of funds in the PD Account, the disbursement process for the beneficiaries whose eligible lists have been approved in the previous (2) Executive Committee Meetings could not be processed. However, the

same have been taken up for disbursement after receiving additional budget from Government.

Out of (661) cases, in respect of (586) cases wherein the beneficiaries have furnished information about their contribution, have been considered for disbursement and proposals have been sent to Finance Department for depositing the respective subsidy amounts into the individual accounts of the beneficiaries. It was informed that in respect of balance (75) cases the beneficiaries are being reminded from time to time to deposit their part of contribution so that their cases can also be further processed.

Further, the Executive Committee have been informed that out of (710) recommended cases (669) cases have been physically verified and out of (669) cases a list of (510) cases which are straightaway qualified has been placed before the Executive Committee for approval and permission for disbursement of subsidy to a tune of Rs.16,76,97,323/- (Rupees Sixteen crores seventy-six lakhs ninety-seven thousand three hundred and twenty-three) to the respective beneficiaries as per the procedure in vogue. The Executive Committee have perused the proposals and approved the same.

The Executive Committee have also been informed about the status of balance (159) applications. The Executive Committee have instructed to take up interviews in respect of pending applications as expeditiously as possible. The Member-Convener of the Selection Committee i.e., Administrator has informed that the interviews for the balance applications would commence from the month of February, 2023.

4. Vivekananda Overseas Education Scheme (VOES):

Under the scheme, fresh applications have been received from 15-10-2022 to 15-11-2022 and by the date of dead line (295) applications were received. The Executive Committee have been informed that out of (295) applications, in the 1st spell as many as (195)

applications were taken up for interview from 21-11-2022 to 26-11-2022 and the selection process had been completed. The details of recommendations of selection committee are as follows:

The Executive Committee have been requested to peruse the recommendations of selection committee and to accord permission for issuing sanction proceedings to the (120) beneficiaries who have straightaway qualified for financial assistance. Accordingly, the Executive Committee have approved the recommendations of the Selection Committee.

5. Sri Ramanuja Scheme:

The Executive Committee have approved the proposal for reimbursing the fee to as many as (21) Post-Metric students who have fulfilled the requirements as per the existing guidelines.

6. Vedahita-Honorarium to Veda/Shashtra Pandits:

The Executive Committee approved the proposal for sanctioning Honorarium @ Rs. 2,500/- per month to two (02) Veda/Shashtra pandits as per the recommendations of Vedic Committee. The details are as follows:

- 1) Sri Gattu Narahari Sharma, aged 76 years, Chennur (V & M), Mancherial (D).
- 2) Sri Vattikota Ramanuja Charya, aged 89 years, Safilguda, Medchal-Malkajgiri (D).

The proposal is placed before the Executive Committee for approval of sanctioning of monthly honorarium of Rs. 2500/- and the same is approved.
