Vedahitha - Vedic Students

Objective:

To encourage Vedic studies and students in the State of Telangana by providing financial assistance.

<u>Scheme</u>:

- a) Payment of Rs.250/- per student / per month as stipend.
- b) Payment of Rs.3.00 Lakhs after successful completion of Smarta studies and Rs.5.00 Lakhs after successful completion of Agama, Kramantha and Ganantha studies as sustainance grant.

<u>Scope</u>:

This scheme is applicable for students of Brahmin community who are pursuing full time Vedic Education (Yajur Veda, Rig Veda, Sama Veda, Atharvana Veda and Smartham).

<u>Eligibility</u>:

- The student and his / her parents should belong to Brahmin community and parents should reside in Telangana State.
- Should be pursuing a full time Vedic course (Yajur Veda, Rig Veda, Sama Veda, Atharvana Veda and Smartham) in any Private Veda Patasala registered with Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) or Endowments Department of Telangana State or enlisted by the Telangana Brahmin Samkshema Parishad.
- For getting admission in the above courses in approved / recognised institutions only.
- The students enrolled and pursuing Vedic Education will be eligible for a stipend of Rs.250/- per month.
- The sustenance allowance will be granted to those who studies a minimum period of 7 years and of 15 years old at the time of leaving institution.
 - a. Payment of Rs.3.00 Lakhs after successful completion of Smarta studies.
 - b. Payment of Rs.5.00 Lakhs after successful completion of Agama, Kramantha and Ganantha studies.
