

**MINUTES OF THE 7<sup>th</sup> SPECIAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF  
TELANGANA BRAHMIN SAMKSEMA PARISHAD HELD ON  
03.05.2023 AT 11.30 AM IN THE OFFICE THE CHAIRMAN,

At the outset, the Chairman TBSP welcomed the Members to the General Body meeting of the Parishad and explained that this meeting is called for to discuss various steps to be taken for the inauguration of Brahmin Sadan at Gopanpally on 31-05-2023 by Hon'ble Chief Minister.

The Chairman has informed the General Body about the completion of Brahmin Sadan at Gopanpally, Rangareddy District and the date of its inauguration on 31-05-2023 at 11:00 AM to the auspicious hands of Hon'ble Chief Minister.

The Members are requested to mobilize the Brahmin population to attend the program. The Women Members are requested to mobilize at least (500) Brahmin women to chant "Lalitha Sahasra Namam" at the venue. The Chairman has assured that conveyance for the local Brahmin public to attend the program would be provided on free of cost.

The Member Secretary and the Administrator, TBSP have been requested to inform the beneficiaries under various schemes about the inauguration and to request them to attend the inaugural function.

Member Secretary stated that Dhoopa Dheepa Naivedyam (DDN) priests will also be requested to be present on the occasion of inaugural function.

The Chairman has placed a proposal before General Body stating that the Office of TBSP might be allowed to function in the present premises i.e. O/o Commissionerate of Endowments, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Boggulakunta, Tilak Road, Hyderabad since it is easily accessible to the vast number of Brahmin families in the State. Shifting of which to the newly constructed Brahmin Sadan at Gopanpally will create trouble of accessibility to many Brahmin folk in the State. The General Body approved the proposal. The Member Secretary and Commissioner of Endowments also agreed the same.

The Chairman has informed the Members that "Sampradaya Patashala" being run by Pratyaksha Charitable Trust under the spiritual guidance of Kanchi Kama Koti Peetam, have been requesting to provide accommodation at Brahmin Sadan for running their school which is presently running in a rented accommodation. The Chairman has stated that providing accommodation "on free of cost" for the Sampradaya School in one of the structures constructed at Brahmin Sadan complex especially in the one which is meant for Seers Accommodation will serve the genuine purpose of Sampradaya School. It is stated that the girl students would get a safe and secure accommodation in the Brahmin Sadan, and further it would lead to continuous

activity of Brahmin community in the Brahmin Sadan premises. It will also have a continuous activity relating to community purpose. The General Body unanimously resolved to provide accommodation to Sampradaya School at Seers Accommodation, Brahmin Sadan, free of cost.

Further, the Chairman has requested the Commissioner, Endowments to invite as many as (25) Veda Pandits belonging to prominent temples in the State.

Further, the Chairman has informed the General Body that Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD) have assured to provide as many as (25) Veda Pandits to attend the program on 31-05-2023. The Members have been requested to see that a total of (50) Veda Pandits be gathered to bless the occasion.

The Chairman has also informed the General Body that Pradhana Archakas from various important temples including that of Dwadasa Jyothirlinga Temples and also nation-wide important Brahmin associations will be invited to bless the occasion. Several Peetadhipathis will also be invited to grace and bless the occasion. The Members of General Body expressed happiness and agreed to this proposal in toto.

Sri Astakala Rammohan, Member, TBSP has been requested to arrange for wall stickers containing Sukthi's.

Further, the Chairman has stated that a meeting of local Brahmin Associations would be conducted on 17-05-2023 to request the Associations for extending necessary co-operation for making inauguration program a grand success.

Dr.Samudrala Venugopala Chary, Member, TBSP stated that the program should be conducted in an unprecedented manner. He stated that the entire work relating to this program should be

divided in to parts and committees have to be constituted to look after such and such item of work as entrusted to them, since the division and entrustment of work will make the task of co-ordination easy. The Members have agreed with his opinion.

Further, General Body have resolved to vest discretionary power in the Chairman, TBSP to take decisions for making program on 31-05-2023 successful.


The General Body have reviewed the progress of implementation of welfare schemes. The Chairman has informed that under Vivekananda Overseas Education Scheme (VOES) since the inception as many as (780) students who are pursuing higher education in foreign Universities have been rendered assistance to a tune of Rs.76,67,52,884/- @ maximum of Rs.20.00 lakhs per head.

Similarly, under Brahmin Entrepreneurial Scheme of Telangana (BEST) as many as (5074) cases have been sanctioned for establishment of self-employment units and an amount of Rs.122,05,64,164/- has been distributed to them. Under Sri Ramanuja Scheme, so far (436) Post-Metric students have been benefitted with an amount of Rs.1,14,64,208/- and (32) Veda Patashalas have been given one-time grant upto Rs.2.00 lakhs. The General Body expressed satisfaction over the way the schemes are being implemented.
