Sri Sankara Samskruti Patashala, Tirupati, functioning under Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam, Kanchipuram, is offering various Courses in Intermediate Education to the Brahmin students of Telangana State, at subsidized fees.

All the courses such as MPC, BiPC, MEC, CEC, etc. shall be in English medium and Sanskrit as the second language with emphasis on courses for competitive examinations like JEE, NEET, CA foundation, CLAT, etc. The institution will also impart Dharmic training to the students ensuring their holistic development besides preparing the students achieve excellence in their chosen professional courses like Medicine, Engineering, C.A., Law, etc.

In addition to the above courses, Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Viswamahavidyalaya, Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu, is also offering all the major Engineering Degree Courses (4-Year Degree) and also Undergraduate (3-Year) and Post-Graduate Degree Courses at their University in Tamilnadu, at subsidized fee, depending upon the eligibility and performance after admission, subject to the condition that the students should secure 70% or 80% marks in their respective Semesters, as per the scale of subsidy. This is also a good opportunity to our Brahmin students.

The Patashala will conduct an ONLINE examination titled "Kamakoti Ghatikasthanam Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Examination" in the month of April, 2023. Brahmin students who qualify in this Examination will be given Admission in the Patashala and that the deserving students will be given Scholarships based on their economic status.
